Truck movements in the Tennyson area on April 26

On Thursday, April 20, a number of meetings were held at the Brisbane Golf Club where details of Early Works and what it comprises were presented to members of the local community and other stakeholders.

Included in those presentations were details of proposed operating hours on site which are as follows:-

7am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday, 7am to 2pm on Saturday's and reduced workforce on site during RDO's or Industry Rostered Day's Off.

Developer Mirvac wishes to advise that on *Wednesday April 26* the Early Works contractor will be moving some large equipment onto the site in preparation for the commencement of Early Works in May.

The largest of these machines is required by law (Brisbane City Council and the Department of Main Roads) to be under police escort and at its destination prior to 6.30am to minimize traffic disruption and the impact on local residents. We apologise for the short notice period in relation to this event, due to circumstances outside our control.

It is anticipated that the first of this equipment will start to arrive at the site via Tennyson Memorial Avenue and Softstone Street shortly after 6am. If the large float carrying the equipment arrives earlier than this it will pull up in Tennyson Memorial Avenue, in the non-residential area, and will not proceed towards Softstone Street until after 6am.

All large scale equipment, requiring a police escort, will be delivered at this time and will be off the roads by 6.30am.

Mirvac wishes to advise you in advance of these deliveries to the site as they will occur out of the normal operating hours.
