



Tennis Centre concern allayed

RESIDENTS' concerns about the roundabout at the entrance to Tennyson's State Tennis Centre development are unfounded, the developer says.

Tennyson Residents Association president Barry Sommerlad said some local residents had expressed concern about the bus stop area.

The roundabout is at the corner of Softstone St and King Arthur Terrace.

Mirvac says its design and position is unchanged from the original Development Application.

Tennyson development director Matthew Wallace said the design drawings shown to residents at community consultation meetings were unchanged.

"Originally there was to be a fairly significant bus station to the south of this entry to the site, but that has been relocated to within the site," Mr Wallace said.
