



Earthworks begin for access road

TENNYSON Riverside Development (TRD) developers are preparing to start soil remediation and have begun work on an access road on Animal Research Institute land bordering the site.

Mirvac has said soil remediation would take about 10 to 12 weeks and would involve transporting

some soil off site.

They will monitor dust control and street cleaning where vehicles access and leave the site.

The access road through the ARI site will eventually provide a link to the Tennyson Reach apartments and the new State Tennis Centre from Fairfield Rd.

Access to the ARI site for these works will be from Ortive St.

Immediately after remediation works are finished, Mirvac will start construction of the new road to link the Tennyson development with Fairfield Rd.

Work will take months and completion is likely to be by February 2008.
