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## Rush on Brisbane flats



The first apartments to be released in the \$675m Tennyson Reach (pictured) luxury residential development on the site of the former Tennyson power station, on the Brisbane River, have been rushed by buyers, with \$170m in sales recorded in just four days. Near the new State Tennis Centre, itself valued at \$100m, the units are 8km from the Brisbane CBD. Mirvac Development Queensland's chief executive Chris Freeman said the sales were mostly to end users from the local area.
