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Stage two release of Tennis Centre units

THE \$555 million Tennyson Reach river-front residential development, which incorporates the State Government's new State Tennis Centre, reached a major milestone this week with the release of stage two of the luxury apartments.

Developer Mirvac released details of the 92 apartments in the second stage, called Farringford apartments, to a limited number of pre-registered prospective purchasers during the week before today's official public launch.

So far \$22 million worth of apartment have been sold.

Mirvac Queensland CEO Chris Freeman said he was happy with the initial sales and predicted that after the public release of the Farringford apartments, sales would perform well.
