Tennyson sets record

Mirvac's \$555 million Tennyson Reach residential block on the banks of the Brisbane River has set a price record for western Brisbane – a penthouse sold for \$5.25 million. Mirvac's general manager-development (Queensland), Matthew Wallace, said the 731 square metre unit was bought by a Brisbane couple. Mirvac released the second stage of the Tennyson project, which is made up of 92 apartments, last December. So far 25 per cent have sold.
